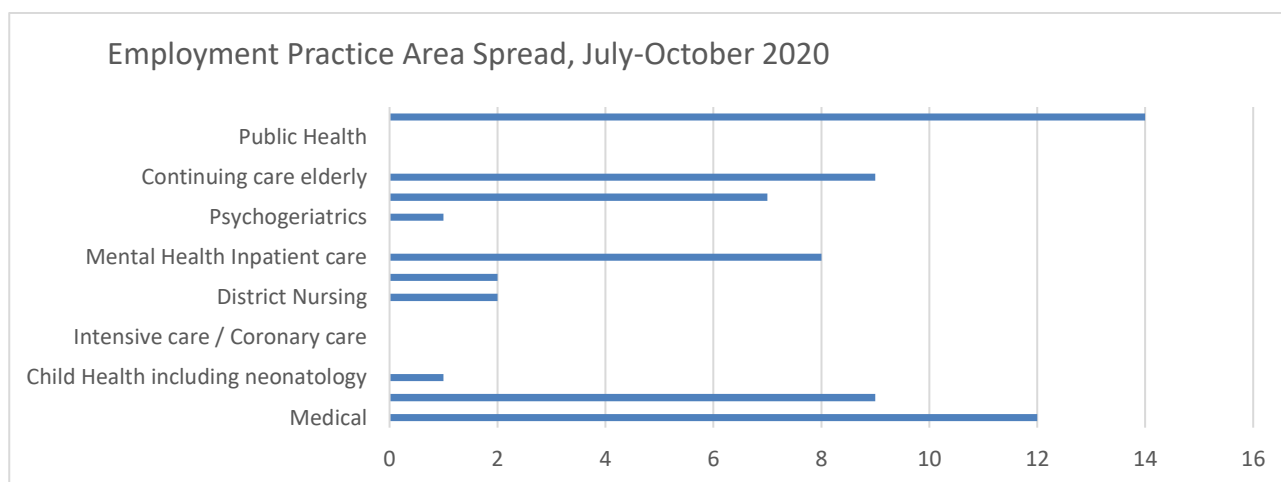


Figure 1: Employment Practice Area Spread (July – October 2020)
